## Blue ruin

An ancient Roman church has been given a spectral afterlife centuries after the original was left to crumble.

The spooky (yet extremely clever) new addition to the Archaeological Park of Siponto, a port town in southern Italy near Naples, was created by Italian installation artist Edoardo Tresoldi over three months using hundreds of metres of wire mesh. Standing on the church's former site, the ghostly sculpture – which features specific details such as tiered columns, domes and sculptures – aims to connect archaeology with contemporary art, and will remain on the site indefinitely.
